**Breast cancer is the most common cancer affecting women in Australia.**

A breast screen (breast X-ray) is currently the most effective screening test for detecting breast cancer in women who have no symptoms.

BreastScreen SA provides **FREE** breast screens for women aged over 40, especially 50 to 74.

**When you visit BreastScreen SA:**

- a breast screen is **free** and takes just **15 minutes**
- you will be screened by a **female** radiographer
- you can bring a friend for **support** or make a group booking
- you can have a female **interpreter** assist you at no cost
