Did you know...

- **If you are a woman aged over 40, especially 50 to 74, with no symptoms of breast cancer, you are eligible for a free screening mammogram with BreastScreen SA.**
- A screening mammogram is currently the only clinically proven way to detect breast cancer early, before symptoms start to show.
- Breast cancer survival rates are improving each year, but the key is early detection. This is why it's so important to have a breast screen every two years.
- Breast cancer can develop between your regular breast screens. It is important that you are breast aware. If you notice any changes in the look or feel of your breasts you should see your doctor promptly to arrange further investigation.
- BreastScreen SA has 8 clinics in the Adelaide area, and 3 mobile screening units that travel to more than 42 locations across the state.
- 9 in 10 women diagnosed with breast cancer have no family history of the disease.
- 75% of all breast cancer cases in Australia are diagnosed in women over the age of 50.
